


HOPE GROWS HERE

Jeff's Place opened in September 2010 with 6 families 19 children. We incorporated in July 2011. Our first home was graciously donated by Temple Shir Tikva in Wayland, and we quickly outgrew the space. Through the generosity of Fenix Partners, we rented a larger space - which we also outgrew. We have provided support to thousands of individuals, and today, we serve more than 65 families (150+ individuals) who attend our programs. We have also provided school and community support throughout Metrowest and beyond. Jeff's Place also provides individual and family counseling and professional educational trainings on childhood bereavement.

In April 2020, after a successful campaign and with your generosity, we were able to purchase our first permanent home.

TRANSFORMING LIVES

Jeff's Place provides FREE support groups that are facilitated by a mental health clinician and an extensively trained volunteer facilitator. We provide support groups for children ages three to 18 as well as their adult caregivers, a young adult group and a grandparent group. We also provide individual counseling. Our other area of direct service is providing educational workshops on childhood bereavement, primarily in schools, corporations and community organizations.

During the pandemic, we not only continued to provide services, but we also added additional programming to meet the growing needs of our community.

Jeff's Place offers hope and healing in a supportive community for grieving children, teens, families and individuals.


